The Department organizes a post-graduate program in Economics with a very low teaching load, a maximum of one course per year. We invite applications for two full-time faculty positions. The first position is for a senior economist in Macroeconomics/Monetary Economics. The successful candidate should have a well-established record of publications in international journals. Tenure can be granted for this position.

The second position is a non-tenured position at the Assistant Professor level (pending funding and approval). Candidates should already have a PhD degree (or equivalent) and possess a well-developed research agenda. Publications in international journals are highly desirable.

We anticipate both positions to begin as soon as possible. Interested applicants should submit a letter of application, curriculum vitae, at least one research paper, and provide 3 names of academic references by September 10, 2006. Applicants who complete their file by August 11, can be interviewed at the EEA-ESEM 2006 Congress, August 24-28. Only completed applications will be considered.
