Description

The Department of Economics of the Erasmus School of Economics and Business Economics in Rotterdam invites applications for several tenure track positions at the junior faculty level in the areas of microeconomics, international economics (multinationals, economic geography, growth), macroeconomics (monetary policy, public finance), and industrial organization.

These research positions will involve a standard teaching load. The successful candidates will work in close collaboration with the Tinbergen Institute, a leading research institute in Europe.

Qualifications

Applicants should have received a doctoral degree. Those who are close to completion or already hold tenure track positions are also invited to apply.

Conditions of employment

Employment starts in January 2007 or later. Contracts will initially be running for a period of 4 years with possible extension of 2 more years.

Depending on your qualifications and age we offer a salary up to € 4,705.- gross, excluding 8% holiday pay and 3% end of year bonus. For researchers from outside the Netherlands, there is the possibility to apply for a tax-free allowance of 30% of the taxable salary. Relocation costs are covered up to a maximum.

Application procedure

Applications should be received not later than August 9th 2006. Interested applicants should send their resume, job market paper, teaching evaluations, a letter of motivation (including reasons to live in the Netherlands) and two letters of recommendation to the address below. Please indicate for which of the above positions you apply. Interviews with the most promising candidates will be scheduled during the EEA/ESEM meeting in Vienna or in Rotterdam.
